Please Read! Indemnity:

- All participants must be self-insured (either by Public Liability or vehicle registration/insurance)
- All participating groups/businesses must submit their current Public Liability Certificate of Currency upon submitting their entry. Please upload to the online form.
- All participants agree to indemnify Falling Leaf Festival Inc against all claims, suits, actions or demands from participating in the Falling Leaf Festival Street Parade.
- All participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless Falling Leaf Festival Inc in the event of any claim for loss, damage or otherwise by any person
- Falling Leaf Festival Inc. does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss to your business/property or participants.

Parade Specific Terms and Conditions

- All participants are responsible for their own personal safety and security. All parade entrants should carry water and sun protection.
- All vehicles must be roadworthy, registered with compliant greenslips or an appropriate permit. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of the public and every person travelling on or in the vehicle.
- 3. All entries must continue in a forward motion through the parade route. Entries must not stop or cause delay. The instructions of the Falling Leaf Festival volunteers,, the Rural Fire Service parade marshalls. Falling Leaf Festival parade representatives, any

- 8. Suitably experienced adults must accompany animals at all times and will be deemed responsible for the animal and crowd safety during the parade and marshalling. Entrants are responsible for collecting animal waste before, during and after the parade. The Falling Leaf Festival reserves the right to assess and/or refuse the involvement of animals on a case by case basis.
- Entrants are not permitted to distribute or throw giveaways directly from the vehicle/float. Entrants may hand out giveaways from person to person on foot while on the parade route. Any food that is handed out must be in sealed packaging.
- The use of fireworks, crackers, sparklers or other pyrotechnics, sirens or water pistols at any time during marshalling or the parade is not permitted (with the exception of emergency vehicles).
- 11. Falling Leaf Festival reserves the right to exclude any group, individual or organisation from participating in the parade.
- 12. Drivers of all vehicles must have zero blood alcohol content.
- 13. All vehicles should be set up so as to ensure the safety of their passengers.
- 14. All drivers must be appropriately licensed for the type of the vehicle being driven.
- 15. No semitrailers or vehicles over 12 metres.
- 16. All passengers (including babies and children) must be restrained when riding in a vehicle. Historic vehicles are exempt if they comply with the NSW RMS Historic Vehicle Policy.
- 17. While entrants are restricted to <10km/hr speed limit, they are also required to maintain a constant speed

other authorised traffic controllers and NSW Police must be obeyed. Parade participants must adhere to the parade route and keep within the parade timeframe. Failure to comply with instructions by officials could result in removal from the parade and exclusion from future parades.

- 4. Entries must proceed in the order designated by the parade organiser
- Participants are reminded that this event takes place in a designated Alcohol Free Zone and alcohol is not permitted.
- Children participating in the parade must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times.
- Photographs/video may be taken and used by the Falling Leaf Festival, sponsors, the media and others to publicly promote the events including on social media.

- and not come to a stop or create excessive space between their entry and the entry in front. NO vehicles are to go in a full circle around the roundabouts.
- 18. Parade participants must be ready and suitably equipped to participate in inclement weather conditions, such as rain or very warm weather.
- 19. Marshalling times it is expected the Parade will commence no later than 1pm. Marshalling begins promptly at 11:30am near Tumut Public School. Information will be sent to participants on exact details, closer to the event.

Failure to comply with terms and conditions may result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future years.
